Intent to Participate Agreement

Any student who wishes to participate in the College Credit Plus (CCP) program must submit this form to the school counseling office **by May 1, 2021**, thus notifying the school officially of the intent to participate in the CCP program during the following school year.

This form provides information about the rules regarding participation in this program. Parent and student signature on this form indicates that you have received information/counseling on the following topics and are in agreement to the terms for participation in College Credit Plus:

1. Program eligibility
2. Process for granting academic credit, athletic eligibility
3. Financial arrangements for tuition, textbooks, and fees
4. Criteria for any transportation aid
5. Available support services at the high school and college
6. Scheduling
7. Possible consequences and benefits of participation, including:
 - a. consequences of failing or not completing a course under the program, including effect on completing graduation requirements
 - b. if a student fails a course and/or withdraws after the 100% refund deadline, the school district will bill the family for the cost of the course(s)
 - c. effect of the grade being included in the student's GPA
 - d. benefits for successfully completing courses under the program, including the possible reduction of time and costs of a college education
8. Academic and social responsibilities of students and parents in this program
9. Information about and encouragement to use the college counseling services
10. Standard information about the program as developed by the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents
11. By signing, I give permission to receive text messages regarding important CC+ announcements through Remind Text messages.
12. By signing, I acknowledge that I have watched the CCP video posted on the school's website.
